



The Stanley J. Dudrick Research Scholar - Application Process

Award Background:

A.S.P.E.N. annually presents the Stanley J. Dudrick Research Scholar Award in recognition and support of an investigator who has shown significant achievements in research, is an A.S.P.E.N. member, demonstrates exceptional research productivity, and the potential to continue to make contributions in the field of nutrition support therapy. This award is intended as a mid-career award and includes a \$5,000 cash award plus formal recognition at Clinical Nutrition Week.

Qualifications: The applicant should

1. Be an A.S.P.E.N. member.
2. Have an advanced degree (MD, PharmD, MS, PhD, or equivalent).
3. Currently be in a training program or have completed formal training in nutritional research/therapy within the past 10-15 years, e.g. mid-career.
4. Have demonstrated exceptional research productivity during and/or following formal training.

Awardee Opportunities and Responsibilities: The awardee

1. Attends the Rhoads Research Lecture at Clinical Nutrition Week to formally receive the cash award and recognition for his/her accomplishments.
2. Organizes an educational symposium for the following year Clinical Nutrition Week, based on his/her research interests.
3. Is strongly requested to author a summary manuscript of the proceedings of his/her Dudrick Symposium for submission to *JPEN*.
4. Serves for two years on the Dudrick Selection Committee to assist in selection of future award recipients. This service involves reading applications, and participating in two conference calls in mid to late fall.

Application Process: Please

1. Complete the attached application. (Career goals, current research, involvement in the research community, citation for 3 publications that describe research by the applicant and that best represent his/her work).
2. Submit a current Curriculum Vitae.
