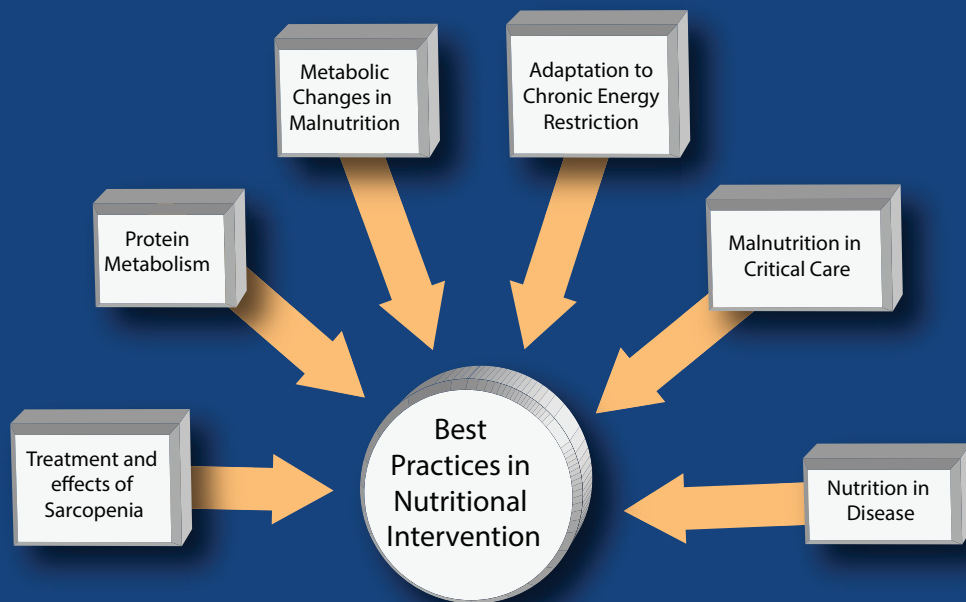


Atlantic Health System's Symposium on Nutrition & Metabolism: Current Concepts in Malnutrition
