Driving Directions to Jewish Hospital Rudd Heart & Lung Conference Center:

Driving East or West on I-64:

Exit at 5A, I-65 South, and follow directions below.

Driving South on I-65:

Exit at 136 C, Jefferson Street (veer right at the fork). From Jefferson Street, turn left on First Street. Turn left on Chestnut Street. Turn left on Brook Street. Turn right immediately after Abraham Flexner Way behind the Rudd Heart and Lung Center. Follow the signs to the Patient Parking Garage.

Driving North on I-65 (2 Routes):

(a.) Exit at 136C, Muhammad Ali Boulevard. Turn right on Muhammad Ali Boulevard. Turn left into Jewish Hospital campus. Proceed to the Patient Parking Garage.

(b.) Exit at 136B Brook Street. Turn right immediately after Abraham Flexner Way behind the Rudd Heart and Lung Center. Follow the signs to the Patient Parking Garage.

There is a \$7.00 charge for parking in the Patient Parking Garage at Jewish Hospital. Parking ticket may be validated at the conference for free parking.
